### ***Controlling Leafy Spurge Using Goats***

Leafy Spurge has proven to be an extremely invasive weed in our area. Spraying with RoundUp™ is somewhat effective but is not always practical. Care must be taken around bodies of water and it will kill desirable plants as well as the spurge. Goats will eat leafy spurge readily and can be used to control it in places where chemical control is not the method of choice. In order to use goats, certain basic precautions must be taken. The goats must be attended at all times or fenced with a portable electric fence to control where they graze. Enough animals must be used so that the weeds are aggressively eaten back. Usually, one session of intense grazing will set the plants back, but it is recommended that they be used more than one time a season to achieve good control. Milking animals may pick up off flavors in their milk, so dry animals would be a better choice where milk quality is important.
